DEVIATION
OVERSEAS TERRITORIES AVIATION REQUIREMENTS
OTAR PART 21

Reissue of Certificate of Airworthiness

The Director General of Civil Aviation of the Bermuda Civil Aviation Authority (BCAA), being designated by the Governor under Article 6 of the Air Navigation (Overseas Territories) Order 2013 (the Order), as amended, in exercise of the Governor's powers under Article 10 of the Order, hereby permits a deviation by the applicant for Reissue of Certificate of Airworthiness who is subject to Overseas Territories Aviation Requirements Part 21 Certification of Aircraft.

A deviation is granted to OTAR Parts 21.181 (b) and (c) in that the Governor is satisfied that an alternate means of compliance and an equal level of safety is assured, to permit a person to make application for the reissue of a Certificate of Airworthiness within 90 days before the expiry date of the certificate and it may be reissued from the date of expiry, subject to all criteria for the reissue being met. This deviation is valid from 9th March 2020 unless suspended, varied or revoked.
