

DEVIATION from OTAR

In accordance with Article 10 of the Air Navigation (Overseas Territories) Order 2013, as amended, BCAA hereby grants the following:

BCAA/PAVE/1388

Requirement

OTAR 125.700 (d) - Medical and emergency equipment

Any extinguishing agent used in a portable fire extinguisher in an aircraft for which the individual certificate of airworthiness is first issued on or after 31 December 2018 shall not be of a type listed in Annex A, Group II of the Montreal Protocol on Substances That Deplete the Ozone Layer, 8th Edition, 2009.

Description of Deviation

Bermuda Civil Aviation Authority hereby authorizes a **Deviation from OTAR 125.700 (d)** requirements to permit Operators of Bermuda Registered Aircraft to non-compliance with the specified OTAR requirements subject to the conditions and period of validity identified below.

Conditions

1. Operators of Bermuda Registered Aircraft will actively search for replacement fire extinguishers to meet the OTAR requirements and advise the Bermuda Civil Aviation Authority (BCAA) when the installation date can be confirmed; and
 2. Operators are to advise the BCAA if this Deviation is applicable to any of their Bermuda registered aircraft.
