**Certificate of Airworthiness Suspension
B737-8 and -9 MAX Aircraft**



This Airworthiness Notice provides information on a mandatory action, required to restore an acceptable level of aviation safety.

This notice is made by the Bermuda Civil Aviation Authority (BCAA) on behalf of The Governor of Bermuda, in the interests of aircraft safety and to protect the Public. Following the accident of an Ethiopian airlines Boeing Model 737-8MAX aircraft on 10th March 2019 and an earlier accident involving a Lion Air aircraft of the same model on 29th October 2018, the BCAA has taken steps necessary to ensure passenger safety.

Given the initial indications of similarity in the two accidents, BCAA has taken the following precautionary mandatory action:

- BCAA hereby provisionally suspends the Certificates of Airworthiness issued to any Boeing 737-8 and -9 MAX aircraft on the Bermuda Aircraft Registry, with effect from 19:00 UTC (16:00ADT) on 12th March 2019.

This Notice is issued under Article 11 of the Air Navigation (Overseas Territories) Order 2013 and will remain in force until further notice.
