

SHIPPING DANGEROUS GOODS AS AIR CARGO & AIR FREIGHT













Dangerous Goods, or Hazardous Materials, are solids, liquids, gases, articles or manufactured products which can harm people, animals, other living organisms, property or the environment.

To enable these items to be transported safely and responsibly in aircraft around the world the International Civil Aviation
Organisation has provided a comprehensive set of Regulations, which are also reproduced by the International Air Transport Association.

These Regulations detail all packing, labelling, marking and documentation requirements which must be followed by anyone wishing to ship Dangerous Goods as Air Cargo/Freight on local (FIGAS) and International flights.









The carriage of all Dangerous Goods is at the discretion of the Airline.
