

DEVIATION from OTAR

In accordance with Article 10 of the Air Navigation (Overseas Territories) Order 2013, as amended, BCAA hereby grants the following:

Requirement

OTAR Part 67 - Medical Standards and Approval of Medical Examiners

Description of Deviation

Bermuda Civil Aviation Authority hereby authorizes a **Deviation** from the above mentioned OTAR requirements to permit BCAA to validate medical certificates issued by the United States of America for the issuance or renewal of an Air Traffic Controller License, in that the Governor is satisfied that an equivalent level of safety is assured subject to the conditions below.

Conditions

1. The candidate shall:
 - a) Hold a Class II FAA medical certificate; and
 - b) The medical certificate shall be current and valid.
2. All restrictions and limitations on the medical certificate shall apply to the BCAA Medical Certificate of Validation.
3. A BCAA Medical Certificate of Validation shall cease to be valid if the medical certificate upon which it was issued is revoked, suspended or otherwise ceases to be valid.
4. During the period of holding a BCAA Medical Certificate of Validation any changes to medical status must be notified to both the State of medical certificate issue, in accordance with its requirements, and to the BCAA.
