

Electronic Flight Bag (E.F.B.) Application Guide

The E.F.B. application is comprised of 2 checklists, <u>Form 9020</u> and <u>Form 9021</u>. You must document normal/contingency procedures and conduct a risk analysis whereby you run a dual paper/paperless trial for one month. The results must be documented and forwarded to the BCAA for Approval. Be advised, modifications or alterations of equipment on the flight deck or similar, will require BCAA Airworthiness approval.
