Fraudulent Approval Certificates under the Name of Temakate OU



1 INTRODUCTION

- 1.1 The Airworthiness Notice is a replacement for the former 'Letter to Operators' (LTOs).
- 1.2 This Airworthiness Notice replaces 'LTO: AIR 01-15' published 26th March 2015. There are no significant differences to the instructions published in 'LTO: AIR 01-15' and this AWN.
- 1.3 The Bermuda regulatory framework requires that the activities related to the airworthiness of aircraft be performed by specific organizations, appropriately rated and by qualified staff to ensure a high degree of compliance to regulation and conformity to standards.

2 BACKGROUND


- 2.1 Recently the Bermuda Civil Aviation Authority (BCAA) was informed by the United Kingdom Civil Aviation Authority (UK CAA) that an organization by the name on the certificates of Temakate OU, with an address of Narva MNT 63, Harajumaa 10152, Tallinn, Estonia, has posted on their web site, counterfeit certificates of approval from the UK CAA, BCAA and Cayman Civil Aviation Authority.

3 INSTRUCTIONS

- 3.1 The UK CAA, BCAA or Cayman Civil Aviation Authority have not issued these approvals and have confirmed that the approval certificates in their name on the company website are also fake. The name of the organisation on the certificates is Temakate OU, with an address of Narva MNT 63, Harajumaa 10152, Tallinn, Estonia. <http://www.aeroms.org/approvals.html>
- 3.2 We are bringing this to your attention to ensure that Bermuda registered aircraft operators, CAMO or AMO do not use the services of this organization.
