Elimination of Bermuda Airworthiness Requirements



1 INTRODUCTION

- 1.1 The Airworthiness Notice is a replacement for the former 'Letter to Operators' (LTOs).
- 1.2 This Airworthiness Notice replaces 'LTO: AIR 04-12' published 16th August 2012. There are no significant differences to the instructions published in 'LTO: AIR 04-12' and this AWN.

2 BACKGROUND

- 2.1 Bermuda Airworthiness Requirements (BARs) were published by the Bermuda Department of Civil Aviation as an airworthiness code, which comprised the minimum requirements and constituted the basis for the issue of approvals and certificates required by the Air Navigation (Overseas Territories) Order.
- 2.2 Currently Overseas Territories Aviation Requirements (OTARs) are published by Air Safety Support International (ASSI) on behalf of Governors of the Overseas Territories (OTs) in support of the Governor's powers contained in the Air Navigation (Overseas Territories) Order (AN(OT)O).
- 2.3 OTARs provide details of means of compliance with the AN(OT)O which are acceptable to the Governor.

3 INSTRUCTIONS

- 3.1 After the introduction and implementation of OTARs, Bermuda Airworthiness Requirements became obsolete and are no longer in effect nor published.
