

DEVIATION from OTAR

In accordance with Article 10 of the Air Navigation (Overseas Territories) Order 2013, as amended, BCAA hereby grants the following:

BCAA/PAVE/1311

Requirement

OTAR 21.181(b) & (c)

- AN(OT)O Article 25 requires that a Certificate of Airworthiness be issued subject to the Governor being satisfied that requirements have been satisfied and the aircraft is fit to fly. OTAR Part 21.181 limits applications for the reissue of a Certificate of Airworthiness, to within 60 days of expiry of an extant certificate.

Description of Deviation

Bermuda Civil Aviation Authority hereby authorizes a **Deviation from OTAR** requirements to permit applicants for the reissue of a Certificate of Airworthiness to apply for reissue within 90 days of the expiry of a certificate and have the new certificate issued from the date of expiry of the extant certificate, subject to the conditions and period of validity identified below.

Conditions

- All application criteria for the reissue have been satisfied
- The aircraft is fit to fly
