

## DEVIATION from OTAR

In accordance with Article 10 of the Air Navigation (Overseas Territories) Order 2013, as amended, BCAA hereby grants the following:

### BCAA/PAVE/1305

#### Requirement

##### OTAR Part 121.1115(a) - Operator Proficiency Checks (OPC)

- Operator Proficiency Checks shall be valid for a period of six calendar months.

##### OTAR Part 121.1120(a) - Operator Line Checks (OLC)

- Operator Line Checks shall be valid for a period of twelve calendar months.

##### OTAR Part 121.1125(a) - Safety and Emergency Procedures Checks (SEPC)

- the SEPC shall be valid for a period of twelve months.

##### OTAR Part 121.1155 - Cabin Crew Competency Checks

- the Cabin Crew Competency Check shall be valid for a period of twelve months.

#### Description of Deviation

Bermuda Civil Aviation Authority hereby authorizes a **Deviation from the above mentioned OTAR** requirements to permit holders of Bermuda Air Operator Certificates ("the Operators") to non-compliance with the specified requirements, subject to the conditions and period of validity identified below.

#### Conditions

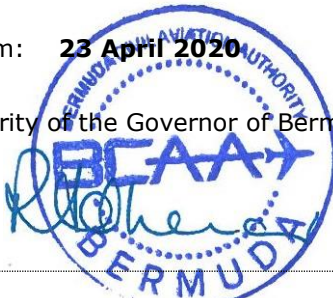
1. They are only applicable to checks that expire before 31st October 2020.
2. They are only valid until 22nd November 2020 and from 23rd November 2020 all operators must ensure that pilots have successfully completed the requirements specified in the Requirements section (i.e. all checks must be renewed as of 23rd November 2020).
3. For Licence Validations to remain valid, licences, type ratings and medicals must comply with the requirements of the State of Issue (e.g. EASA/FAA).
4. Operators must inform BCAA if use is to be made of any of these Deviation.
